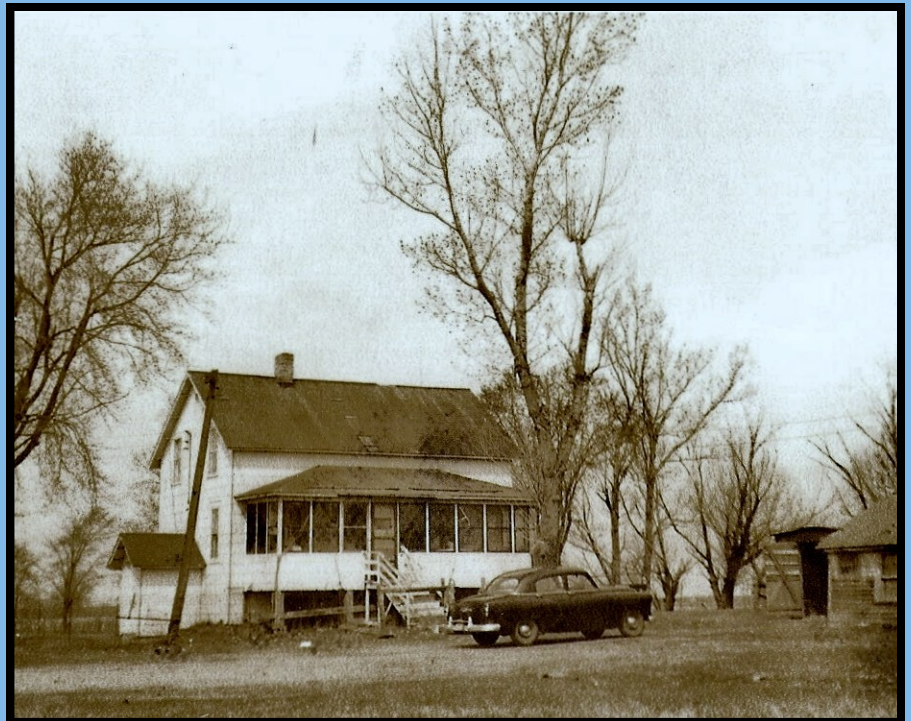


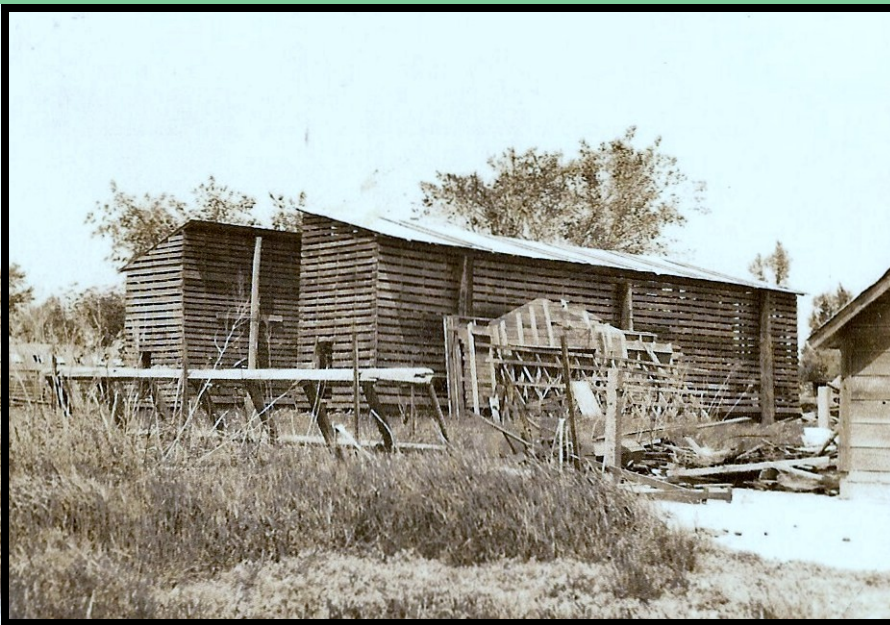
Postcard of “The Hotel Radisson” in Minneapolis
